After your initial call to AML's office, our grant writing consultant will be provided with your contact information. She will call you to discuss your grant needs, grant opportunities, and other questions you might have. Discussions can include all or any of the following grant-related topics:

1. Needs of your community/Tribe/entity
2. Options for grant opportunities that are relevant to the identified needs
3. Budgets, audits, and other requirements for grant applications
4. Schedules, resources and research needed to prepare your grant application
5. Requirements for registration in SAM.gov
6. Requirements for registration in Grants.gov
7. Previous grant awards of your Tribe or entity
8. Outstanding debts that could impact your application
9. Time for questions: we're here to help!
