Alaska's Grant Writer Hotline

If your municipality, tribe, or other organization wants help with grant writing, the Alaska Municipal League and its Federal Funding partners offer the Grant Writer Hotline – a FREE pre-grant application consultation to talk through your interests, eligibility, and processes for funding opportunities with an experienced grant writer.

Using the Grant Writer Hotline:

1. **Contact staff at the Alaska Municipal League**, who are coordinating the hotline. They will share your contact information and a short statement of need with the hotline grant writer. Reach out at **(907) 586-1325** or **membersupport@akml.org**.
2. **The grant writer hotline operator will contact you** for your thirty-to-sixty-minute pre-grant application consultation. Your conversation can include topics like:
 - Needs of your community & organization
 - Options for grant opportunities that are relevant to the identified needs
 - Budgets, audits, and other requirements for grant applications
 - Schedules, resources, and research needed to prepare your applications
 - Requirements for registration in SAM.gov
 - Requirements for registration in Grants.gov
 - Previous grant awards that your organization has received
 - Outstanding debts that could impact your application
 - Time for questions: we're here to help

While the Grant Writer Hotline isn't intended to provide full grant-writing services, once you've had your consultation you can consider hiring or contracting a grant writer to continue the work.
